



### **Did You Know?**

Healing Gardens for Victims-Survivors in the Archdiocese's Five Pastoral Regions

The Archdiocese of Los Angeles has created gardens of healing in each of the Archdiocese's pastoral regions, dedicated to those harmed by sexual abuse, in their family, church or community. Located at St. Camillus Pastoral Center in Los Angeles (Our Lady of Los Angeles Pastoral Region), Our Lady of the Assumption Parish in Ventura (Santa Barbara Pastoral Region), St. Francis de Sales Parish, Sherman Oaks (San Fernando Pastoral Region), and St. Bernadette Parish, Los Angeles (San Gabriel Pastoral Region), these gardens offer a sacred space for all those impacted by abuse to seek comfort and solace. A fifth garden is being built at St. Pancratius Parish in Lakewood (San Pedro Pastoral Region). In each garden, there is a weeping wall and a plaque with a reflection by Archbishop Gomez, which starts with this paragraph: "Dedicated to all those impacted by sexual abuse in the Church, their communities, their families may all who visit find some measure of renewal, peace and comfort in doing so."

# **Cardinal McIntyre Fund for Charity**

Second Collection April 27<sup>th</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup>

In 1948, shortly after he was appointed Archbishop of Los Angeles, Cardinal James Francis McIntyre recognized that certain institutions and agencies were facing hardships because of inadequate financing.

These organizations were ineligible for funding through public sources such as the Community Chests (predecessor to the United Way) and included: family welfare, institutions for the aged, health and youth services, adoption agencies, care for the blind, hard of hearing, mentally challenged and handicapped. Also needed were funds for maternity care, emergency relief and expanded social services in distressed neighborhoods.


"The Fund" provides emergency help to persons who have nowhere else to go. The Fund is not a replacement or supplement for welfare or other forms of public assistance. It does not support the person's living needs on a continuing basis. Rather, The Fund acts to solve immediate, pressing problems: food and milk for three days, lodging for the night, emergency medical care, rent to tide over a financial crisis or a utility bill to keep the water or heat turned on for the week.

As the Archdiocese of Los Angeles' Safeguard the Children Office marks its 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary, the office looks forward to the future with renewed determination and commitment to ensure that our children and young people have the opportunity to grow up in a safe, nurturing and supportive environment.

"The Victims Assistance Ministry continues its ministry of accompaniment of victim-survivors with the intention of making manifest and tangible the church's commitment to those harmed by the sexual misconduct of someone in our church," said Dr. Heather Banis, the office's coordinator. "We are here, and have been here for over 20 years to respond to survivors and their loved ones with compassion, while ensuring that the appropriate civil authorities are notified of the misconduct, coordinating healing resources, and continuously striving to deepen the Church's understanding of the needs and hopes of victim-survivors. I am humbled and honored to serve in this ministry."
