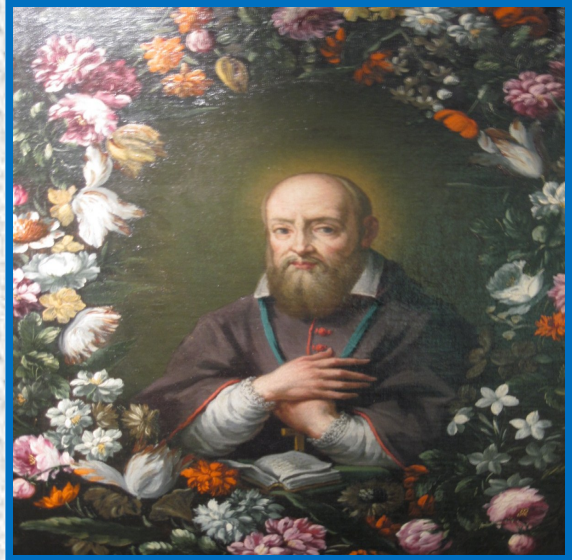

Father's Day

The beginning of Father's Day is generally credited to Sonora Smart Dodd of Spokane, Washington. Her father was a Civil War Veteran who raised Sonora and her five siblings as a single parent, after his wife died giving birth to their last child. Sonora got the idea of honoring fathers while listening to a sermon on Mother's Day (started by Anna Jarvis in 1908) in 1909.

The next year, the first Father's Day was celebrated on June 19, 1910; the month of the birthday of Sonora's father. In 1924, President Coolidge gave his support to a national observance of Father's Day, and in 1966 President Johnson proclaimed it a national holiday.

You may honor your father, grandfather, godfather, uncle, father figure, friend by placing his/their names in the Father's Day Novena of Masses. The nine Masses of the Father's Day Novena will begin on Father's Day, June 21 thru 29. Get an envelope from the pew, write the names of those you wish remembered in the Father's Day Novena of Masses, enclose your donation and return the completed envelope to the Parish Center or Collection Basket.
